Many hotel chains and tour operators say that they take their environmental commitments seriously, but often they do not respect their social and economic responsibilities to the local community. So is it possible for travelers to improve the incomes of locals and still have a good holiday?

The charity, **Tourism Concern**, thinks so. It has pioneered the concept of the fair-trade holiday. The philosophy behind fair-trade travel is to make sure that local people get a fair share of the income from tourism. The objectives of the organization are simple: employing local people whenever possible; offering fair wages and treatment; showing cultural respect; involving communities in deciding how tourism is developed; and making sure that visitors have the minimal environmental impact.

Although there is currently no official fair-trade accreditation for holidays, the Association of Independent Tour Operators has worked hard to produce responsible tourism guidelines for its members. Some new companies, operated on principles as well as profits, offer a fantastic range of holidays for responsible and adventurous travelers.

#### Questions 37 - 40

"Hipster is not a real job" — That's one of the key messages of an advertisement campaign launched by the Canadian province, British Columbia (B.C.). The B.C. government has used the ad to attract young people and get them into job training. The province has **projected** a labor shortage in shipping, natural gas, and mining industries in coming years.

The "Hipster" ad targets youths who reject mainstream values and fashion. Stereotypical hipsters wear glasses with thick plastic frames, tight jeans, and ironic T-shirts; they prefer working in cafes rather than factories. Online commentators have shown both support for and disapproval of the ad's suggestion that hipsters lack ambition.

The B.C. government believes that among a million job openings expected by 2020, 43 percent will require skilled workers. Meanwhile, another study by Skills Canada revealed that only about a quarter of young people were considering a career path in trades. The government hopes to solve this problem as soon as possible. "We chose to go with a theme that would catch the attention of our youth and create buzz, create discussion," said Minister of Jobs, Pat Bell. Considering the online debate, the ad has been a success.
